

Security Deposit Agreement PianoLessonsNJ.com

Please save this for your records!!

This agreement is between _____, the adult student, or legal guardian of the minor student stated above, and Dina Melucci, Instructor, of PianoLessonsNJ.com.

The student shall give Dina Melucci a Security Deposit of \$40.00. This deposit may be refunded at the time the student wishes to discontinue lessons, provided none of the following has occurred.

The Security Deposit will be forfeited in the event of any of the following:

- A student shows up for a lesson without adequate payment.
- A student fails to show up for a scheduled lesson or is a half hour+ late.
- A student cancels a lessons without adequate notice. Adequate notice is 4 hours for lessons 1:00PM or later; the night before for lessons before 1:00PM.
- A student does cancel a lesson with notice, but it's the third time in a row. This means canceling three consecutive scheduled lessons, even if you show up for the re-scheduled lessons in between.
- A student cancels (with or without rescheduling) a lesson for the fifth time that year. You are allotted five (5) cancellations per year. A cancellation is any time you cannot make your scheduled lesson, regardless of rescheduling (whether you reschedule for the next day, the next week, or even later that evening). Anytime the date or time of a lesson is changed it is considered a cancellation Be careful when scheduling your lessons. Upon your fifth cancellation you will be asked to renew your security deposit. Once you renew your deposit, the year will start again and you will have another 5 cancellations before you have to renew again. This same procedure is used in the event of "3 in a row" or the other above scenarios.
- A student, or any person accompanying the student causes damage to my property.
- A student shows up ill and the lesson cannot be given. (See the section on "Children's Colds" in the Full Studio Policy for more details regarding this.)

If any of these things occur, your security deposit will be forfeited and you will have to be re-instated before you can schedule another lesson.

To be re-instated: Mail me a check (or use Paypal) for \$40.00 (this is renewing your security deposit) plus prepayment of the next lesson. The procedure will then start again.

Please note: Should you decide to discontinue lessons while your Security deposit is still active, you may request and be given a full refund. However, when you do come back in the future for a lesson, the first lesson price will apply. This does *not* apply should you loose your Deposit, and you reinstate it. You will continue to pay the Second Lesson price.
