## Covid Protocol for Indoor Lessons at PianoLessonsNJ.com

Being we will be sharing the same piano, sitting in very close proximity during an indoor piano lesson, 6 ft. distancing is not possible. I may even need to touch your finger. We need to take extra precautions. Please read carefully before scheduling an indoor piano lesson.

## Precautions I will be taking:

- I will wash and sanitize the piano keyboard before and after every student.
- I will wash my hands before every lesson (as I always have).
- I will also use hand sanitizer after washing.
- I will spray the room with disinfectant (Lysol) before and after each student.
- I will keep the windows open for ventilation., and, if not freezing, use the ceiling fan for air circulation.
- I will wear a KN95 compliant mask, the one shown here <a href="https://www.ebay.com/itm/174294122727">https://www.ebay.com/itm/174294122727</a> which has an interior replaceable PMS.5 filter, shown here <a href="https://www.ebay.com/itm/193657220285">https://www.ebay.com/itm/193657220285</a> Which I highly recommend as they not only have the same function as a KN95 mask they are fashionable in a variety of colors!

## Requirements for Indoor Lesson **Students**:

- Indoor lessons are available to vaccinated adults only
- If you bring someone with you, please be sure they are vaccinated as well.
- Please wash your hands before going to the piano. You may use the bathroom, or a Wet Wipes I will provide.
- Also use the sanitizer I will provide after washing your hands and before going to piano.
- Please cancel lesson if you have any symptoms, even of the common cold.
- Please wear a ONLY a **KN95** type mask like the one shown here <a href="https://www.ebay.com/itm/154800166225?var=454900705012">https://www.ebay.com/itm/154800166225?var=454900705012</a> OR the mask with inserts I use (see links above).
- Please do NOT use a disposable surgical mask, a cloth mask, mask with a non-filtered exhalation hole, or any other type of face covering. KN95 only or better.
- Please don mask prior to entering and keep on until after you are outside.
- If you need to remove mask to blow your nose or what ever, kindly step out the door.

If you are not comfortable following these guidelines, we are available for outdoor lessons April-November, and zoom lessons all year round.
